

FloLogic® System 3.0 Warranty (for Customers in the United States)

In consideration for your purchase of the FloLogic System 3.0,

Keep your receipt.
Proof of the original purchase date is needed to obtain service under the warranty

For The Period Of: We Will Replace:

One Year

From the date of the original purchase

Any part of the FloLogic System which fails due to a defect in materials or workmanship. During this **limited one-year warranty**, FloLogic will repair or replace, **free of charge**, any defective part of the System 3.0. You will be responsible for any in-home service and return shipping of the defective part to FloLogic.

Five Years

From the date of the original purchase

The primary flow path including the valve and low-flow diverter, if either fails due to a defect in materials or workmanship. During this **five year limited warranty**, you will be responsible for any in-home service and return shipping charges.

What Is Not Covered

- Service trips to your home to teach you how to use the product.
- Improper installation, delivery, or maintenance.
- Failure of the product if it is abused, misused, or used for other than the intended purpose.
- Defects that result from improper installation or damage not caused by FloLogic.
- Liability on the part of FloLogic under this or any other warranty for any indirect or consequential damage.
- Defective operation of the System due to user programming errors.
- Damage or operational deficiencies due to water quality issues such as sediment or scale accumulation.
- Replacement of house fuses or resetting of circuit breakers.
- Battery replacements.
- Damage to the product caused by accident, fire, floods, or acts of God.
- Incidental or consequential damage caused by possible defects with this product, its installation, or repair.
- Damage caused after delivery.

This warranty is extended to the original purchaser and is transferable to any succeeding owner for products purchased for use within the USA. In Alaska and Hawaii, the warranty excludes the cost of shipping repair or replacement parts to your home or business.

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may have other rights which vary from state to state. To know what your legal rights are, consult your local or state consumer affairs office or your state's Attorney General.
